New orientation of Kisoboka e.V.: setting up an own project in Uganda

After two years (from 2015 until end of 2016), the organization has ended the cooperation with the primary school & orphanage center “Good Samaritan” in Entebbe.

This decision has been made after major deliberation due to a new state of affairs. It has come to a breach of trust with the management of the school. They have tried to influence the financial affairs and they have questioned the decisions made by Kisoboka e.V. This led to a hostile tuned action towards Kisoboka e.V. and queried the agreed principles based on the partnership. Consequently, a partnership as equals is not given any more from Kisoboka`s standpoint. Therefore, the break to the end of this ongoing year is the logical corollary.

Over a period of two years, Kisoboka e.V. has been successfully improving the infrastructure of the school by restructuring the forecourt, by fencing the school grounds, by supplying new school uniforms and by renovating the interior and exterior of the school. From begin on, the students received due to Kisoboka`s engagement a daily warm lunch and the salaries of qualified teachers have been secured. Altogether, these were major improvements for this school.

Kisoboka e.V. has come to the conclusion to setup an own project to support orphans and vulnerable children in Uganda. First, this requires a planning and survey phase in which questions about the location, potential land, legal affairs and so on will be sorted out together with the Ugandan project coordinator Mike. After that, the building phase can start. In sum this will take up to a timetable of 1 to 1.5 years.
